Executive Summary:

At its meeting held on 20th September 2017 the Overview and Scrutiny Committee agreed to develop a survey to be circulated to businesses in the District to discover the local needs and development plans going forward. Members felt this was an opportunity to engage with local businesses and gain an insight into the difficulties faced by growing businesses.

Authority was delegated to Councillor Rose to collect potential questions from the Committee and collate these prior to submission the Governance Team. Once these had been received by the Governance Team, Members' questions, together with additional questions put forward by Officers were assembled into an online survey.

The survey was circulated by email to Businesses across the District in November 2017 and 16 responses were by the survey deadline of 17th January 2018. The details of these responses can be found in the body of this report.

Background

A survey looking at local business needs and development requirements had been developed and circulated to over 3000 businesses across the District. The survey had been completed by a total of 16 businesses from a variety of different sectors including:

- Trade Association,
- Care of the Elderly,
- Development and Transport,
- Health and Safety,
- Office Furniture,
- Agriculture,
- Retail,
- Training,
- Education and Charity,
- Temporary Traffic Management and Road Safety Services,
- Childcare,
- Design,
- Manufacturing,
- Construction and Wholesale.

Survey Results

From the 16 responses received the following data was collected;

- Of those who responded 7 out of 16 were smaller businesses, employing no more than 6 people, whilst the remaining business had a wider range of employee numbers, hiring between 10 and 180.
- 9 of the business who had responded had been at their current site for less than 10 years, 6 had been there for more than 10 years, and one of the businesses had been at their current location for 250 years.
- Of those surveyed, only three businesses indicated that their staff did not have sufficient parking at their business location and only four had indicated that non business parking was causing detriment to the business at their location.
- 11 out of the 16 responses received considered that the infrastructure at their business location was unacceptable and 10 out of the 16 could not accommodate large vehicles or lorries on their business estate.
- 50% of businesses surveyed considered that there were no premises available in the District to enable their business to grow and 9 out of the 16 surveyed indicated that if new business premises or office space was constructed in the Braintree District they would consider a move or business expansion. Of the 16 businesses surveyed, 13 felt that more grow on premises should be considered by the Council.
- The responses had indicated that 75% of the businesses provided employees with an area away from the workplace to consume food and drink; however

75% of business did not have any food or refreshment outlets accessible to employees at their business location.

- 75% of businesses surveyed believed that the expansion of the Witham to Braintree Railway Line to Stansted would benefit the District.

The survey included a question referring to the responsibility of Braintree District Council and what could be done under its capacity as the Local Authority to help increase investment into the District. Some of the areas for improvement indicated are as follows;

- Improve broadband and postal services in rural areas.
- Support local community groups.
- Improve access to Business Parks and availability of food and drink facilities.
- Improve infrastructure, roads, signage and traffic flows.
- Support rural business development in terms of facilitating housing development, supporting and developing services, planning and business rates.
- Improve roads and property for business enterprises with reasonable charges.
- Encourage the Highway Authorities (ECC & Highways England) to improve transport links in the District, in particular the A120 Braintree to A12.
- Improve rail links to the District by lobbying the extension of the Braintree branch line to Stansted.
- Invest in high quality, accessible and well serviced business premises, making the District an attractive place to work.
- Increase availability of affordable rentable premises suitable for business use.
- Improve and simplify planning procedure to become more efficient and transparent.
- Reduction of business rates.
- Accessibility to Superfast Fibre Broadband throughout the District.
