- 1.2 To amend the statement in the Cabinet report that there is an allocated budget of £200,000 in capital budget not £260,000 as detailed in the published report this is because a £60,000 was transferred as a virement under delegated decision to partly fund the Emergency Boiler replacement works at Braintree Sport & Health on 11th March 2022. In March 2022, £60,000 of this capital budget was offset to fund the emergency replacement of the boilers at Braintree Sport & Health Club by delegated decision taken by Corporate Director leaving £200,000 in the Council's capital budget for this project. The tender now received is still within budget and no further capital request is required. The Council's contribution will remain at £180,616.99, and the remaining £60,927.46 is funded by a local grant agreement with Tabor Academy under Joint Use Agreement.
